Granite

Use and Care Guidelines

The durability of Granite countertops is unquestionable. However, to ensure your countertops stay as beautiful as the day they were installed, it is necessary to follow a few simple guidelines.

Daily Cleaning & Care

- A damp cloth or paper towel should be used for routine daily cleaning of dirt and residue. If necessary a pH neutral, non-abrasive cleaner can be used.
- Wipe up wet spills immediately, especially acidic liquids like citrus juice, alcohol or soda. Use coasters under drinking glasses.
- On stubborn or dried spills, use a non-abrasive cleaning pad (such as a white 3M Scotch-Brite® pad) with a stone cleaner (we recommend products by Stone Care International, www.stonecare.com).
- Avoid using harsh chemical or abrasive cleaners. Never wipe your countertop with an acidic cleaner like vinegar or lemon.

Caring for Countertop Finish

- Granite countertops require a protective sealant. Your granite countertops were sealed at installation. However, we recommend sealing your tops again as soon as possible.
- Granite sealants are available at most home improvement centers and hardware stores. We also recommend products by Stone Care International (www.stonecare.com). Follow product instructions.

Preventing Heat Damage

Granite material can withstand exposure from normal cooking temperatures. However, it is important to minimize direct heat exposure to protect your countertop surface.

- We recommend using heat trivets or hot pads when placing hot objects on any surface.

Preventing Other Damage

- Although Granite is resistant to scratches we DO NOT recommend cutting directly on your countertop. We suggest using a cutting board.
